Notice is hereby given that a copy of the VOTERS LIST may be revised at:

33 Railway Ave., Waskada, Manitoba during regular office hours, Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:30 AM - Noon and 1:00-4:30 PM

At this time the Senior Election Official (SEO) will be available to update the voters list by:

- (a) adding the names of voters who are entitled to have their names on the list;
- (b) deleting the names of persons who are not entitled to have their names on the list; and
- (c) making such other correction of errors to the list as required.

VOTER ELIGIBILITY:

A person is eligible to have his or her name added to the Voters List if he or she is:

- 1) a Canadian citizen and at least 18 years of age on election day; and
- 2) a resident of the local authority for at least six months prior to election day, OR a registered owner of land in the municipality for at least six months prior to election day.

NON-RESIDENT VOTERS QUALIFIED IN MORE THAN ONE WARD:

In accordance with Section 25(2) of The Municipal Councils and School Boards Elections Act, any non-resident voter who owns property in more than one ward is responsible to notify the S.E.O in writing, not later than **September 22, 2026** of the ward in which he/she desires to vote. Failing the foregoing, the voter's name will be placed on the list as the SEO may select.

APPLICATION FOR PERSONAL SECURITY PROTECTION:

A voter may apply in writing to the SEO (at the address/email below) no later than **September 22, 2026** to have his/her name and other personal information omitted or obscured from the voters list in order to protect the voter's personal security. The application may be submitted in person, by mail, or email and must include your name, address and include proof of identity.

All changes to the voters list must be completed on or before September 22, 2026.

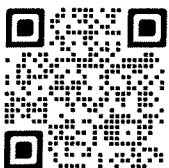


This pilot project has come to a close but we hope to bring back bale wrap and silage plastic collections as soon as a funding opportunity arises.

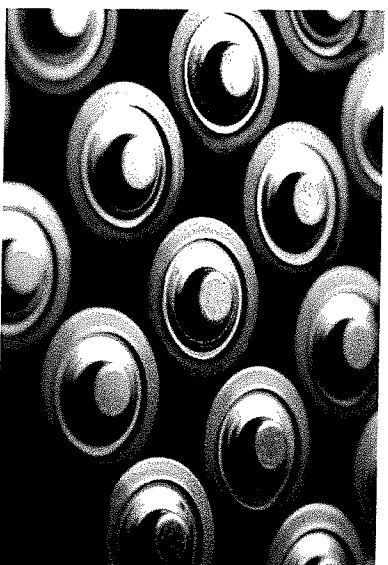

EMERGENCY TELEPHONE NUMBER

911 is to be used for emergency situations – there is no local alternative

Emergency Operators have been trained in Emergency Medical Dispatch and Fire Priority Dispatch. They will ask a series of questions as well as tell you what to do until help arrives.

POLICE, FIRE, AMBULANCE dial 911

Six Things to Tell the Operator When You Need Help:

1. Who you need -- Police, Fire or Ambulance
2. Where you need the help (your address or location)
3. What is happening now
4. How did it happen
5. When did it happen
6. Your name

Helpful Hints

Teach everyone in your family how to make emergency calls. If you accidentally call 911, stay on the line so the operator knows that help is not needed; otherwise, the operator will notify the Police to investigate.

To be prepared, have the following information by your phone:

- The 911 number
- Your address
- Your phone number
