IN THE KNOW – EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR EVERYONE

Weather Alerts

Environment Canada uses a **yellow, orange, or red** banner to show a weather event's severity. All three indicate weather that may cause disruption to property and/or person.

YELLOW - hazardous weather with impacts that are moderate, localized and/or short-term.

ORANGE - severe weather impacts of significant widespread damage and/or last several days.

RED - very dangerous and possibly life-threatening weather with impacts that are widespread and prolonged.

Other weather warnings and watches

In addition to colour coded alerts to get your attention and provide you with basic information, Environment Canada may also issue other types of weather-related warnings.

Air Quality Warnings

Let you know when specific air quality situations, like smoke or dust, may impact you.

Weather statements

Different types of weather statements provide extra detail about weather events. They are not colour coded.

Special Weather Statements

Provide extra information about weather conditions that are unusual, inconvenient, or are cause for potential concern. They are not an alert.

Tours

Tours are provided for the six buildings on site and the collections of pioneer artifacts dating back to the late 1800s.

Buildings

Original buildings are the Menota School, Amos Blacksmith Shop, Union Bank, the Coal Shed and former Anglican Church converted into display buildings. The Vehicle Building was constructed in 1999 and contains a steam engine, threshing machine, binder, water wagon as well as fire trucks, a fire wagon, vintage tractors, cars, buggies.

On display

Items related to early 1900s pioneer lifestyles:
household, clothing, farming, church, banking, former businesses, hunting, sports, carpentry, medicine, school, blacksmithing, military.

New this year

- Oil field battery site diorama donated to the museum by Tundra Oil
- 1920s clothing mannequin display and other personal items
- 222nd Battalion pins (1916)
- Pharmaceutical display in a new lighted display case, featuring items from two druggists, W.E. Shields and E. Brotheridge who provided services in Waskada from 1904 -1981.
