You may run for municipal office if you:

- Are a Canadian citizen;
- Are at least 18 years of age on Election Day;
- Are a resident of Manitoba;
- Are a qualified voter of the municipality or LUD (you have either resided or owned property in the municipality or LUD for at least six months); and
- Have not been disqualified from running under *The Municipal Act*,
