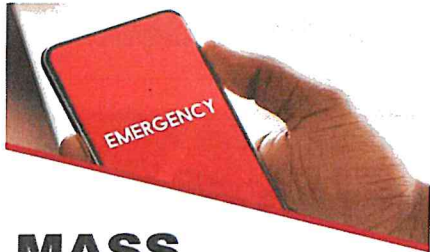

Mass notifications are utilized for a variety of reasons:

- Emergencies (Fire, Severe Weather – i.e., Tornado, etc.,)
- Water (water main break, temporary shut off)
- Recreation groups
- And more!

A few frequently asked questions:

1. Can I run as a candidate for Councillor in a ward that I do not reside or own property in, as long as I reside or own property in the municipality?

Answer:

If you meet the qualifications requirements to run for office in your municipality, you may run as a candidate in any ward in the municipality, even if you reside or own property in a different ward.

2. What are the qualifications to run for municipal council?
3. Answer:

You may run for municipal office if you:

- Are a Canadian citizen;
- Are at least 18 years of age on Election Day;
- Are a resident of Manitoba;
- Are a qualified voter of the municipality (you have either resided or owned property in the municipality for at least six months); and
- Have not been disqualified from running under *The Municipal Act*, or any other Act

Registration for candidates begin:

May 1 for Reeve

June 30 for Councillors
