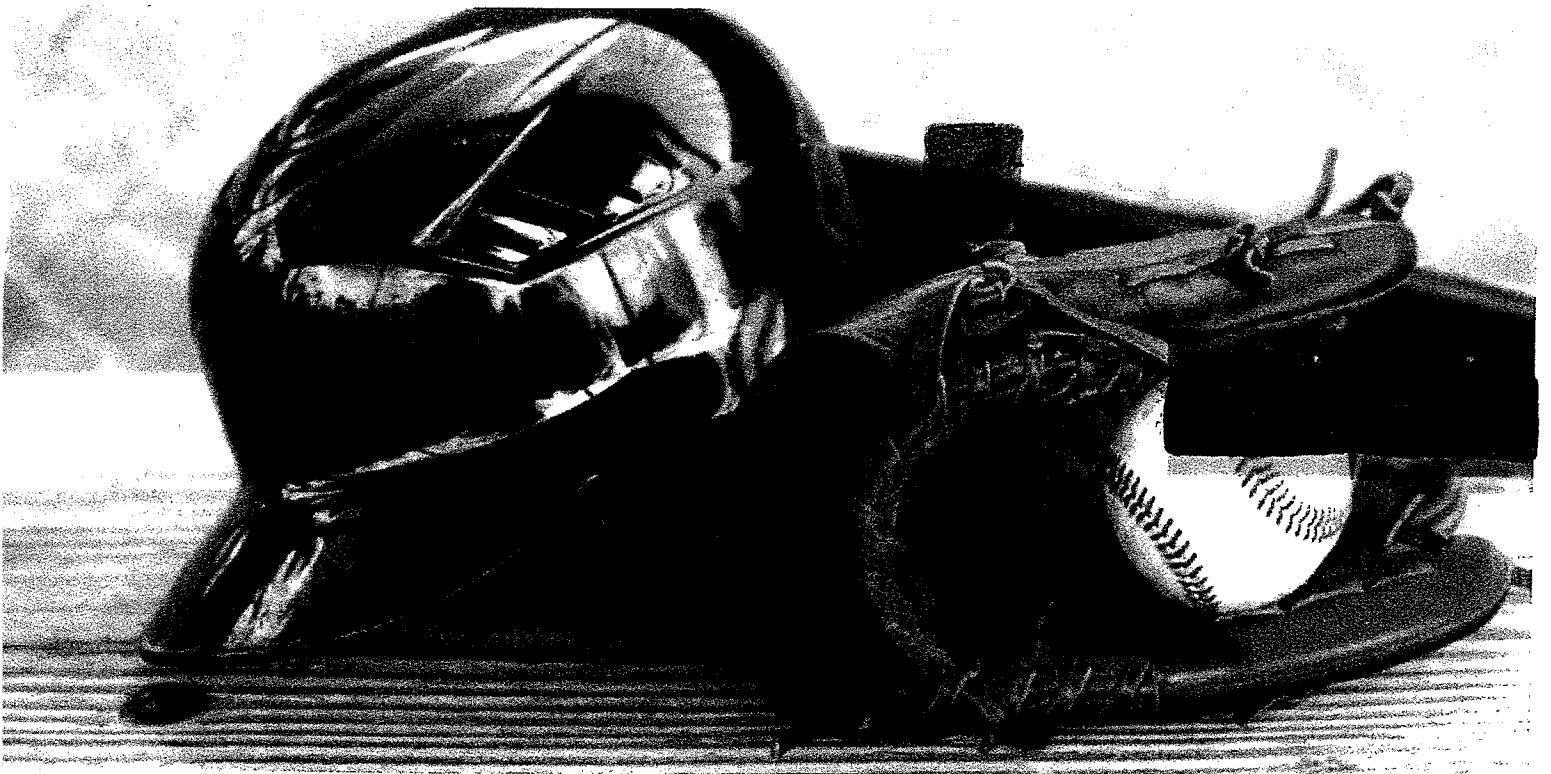

NOTICE OF VOTERS LIST / PERSONAL SECURITY PROTECTION

MUNICIPALITY OF BRENDA-WASKADA

Notice is hereby given that a copy of the VOTERS LIST may be revised at:

33 Railway Ave., Waskada, Manitoba during regular office hours, Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:30 AM - Noon and 1:00-4:30 PM

At this time the Senior Election Official (SEO) will be available to update the voters list by:

- (a) adding the names of voters who are entitled to have their names on the list;
- (b) deleting the names of persons who are not entitled to have their names on the list; and
- (c) making such other correction of errors to the list as required.

VOTER ELIGIBILITY:

A person is eligible to have his or her name added to the Voters List if he or she is:

- 1) a Canadian citizen and at least 18 years of age on election day; and
- 2) a resident of the local authority for at least six months prior to election day, OR a registered owner of land in the municipality for at least six months prior to election day.

NON-RESIDENT VOTERS QUALIFIED IN MORE THAN ONE WARD:

In accordance with Section 25(2) of The Municipal Councils and School Boards Elections Act, any non-resident voter who owns property in more than one ward is responsible to notify the S.E.O in writing, not later than **September 22, 2026** of the ward in which he/she desires to vote. Failing the foregoing, the voter's name will be placed on the list as the SEO may select.

APPLICATION FOR PERSONAL SECURITY PROTECTION:

A voter may apply in writing to the SEO (at the address/email below) no later than **September 22, 2026** to have his/her name and other personal information omitted or obscured from the voters list in order to protect the voter's personal security. The application may be submitted in person, by mail, or email and must include your name, address and include proof of identity.

All changes to the voters list must be completed on or before September 22, 2026.

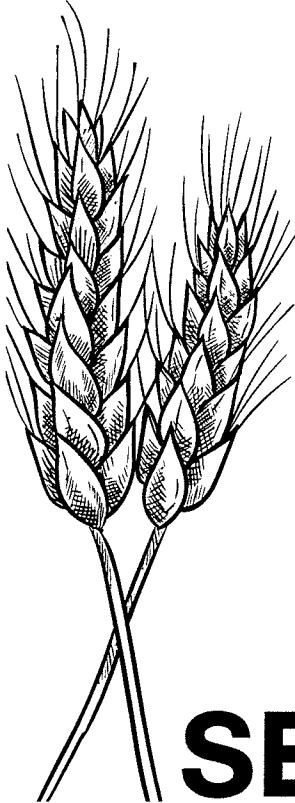

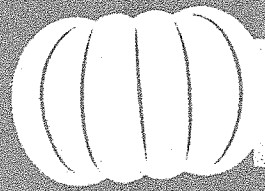

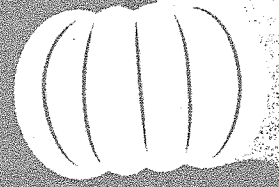

IN THE KNOW – EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR EVERYONE

If you suffered damage to personal property due to the rains received in July this year you may be eligible for Disaster Financial Assistance. A program was announced July 10, 2026 with a submission deadline of October 8, 2026.

Step 1: Document and Check Insurance

- Take clear photos or videos of all damaged property and essential items before cleaning up.
- Keep a detailed list of all emergency activities, hours, and out-of-pocket costs.
- Save all receipts, invoices, and contractor estimates.
- Contact your insurance broker or provider to check what personal policies cover and get a denial or coverage letter for uninsurable items.

Step 2: Apply for Assistance

- Submit your application through the Manitoba EMO DFA Portal within **90 days** of the official program announcement.
- If you prefer offline methods, call the EMO office at 204-945-3050 (or toll-free at 1-888-267-8298) or contact Brenda-Waskada municipal office who can provide a physical form.
- Fill out all property and ownership details completely.

Step 3: Screening and Inspection

- An EMO Recovery Advisor will contact you to perform a brief telephone screening to check basic eligibility.
- If you qualify, an onsite inspection or a rapid damage assessment review will be scheduled with an assigned inspector.
- Keep your assigned claim number handy for all future inquiries and document submissions
